Nominated to the U.S. District Court for the District of Maryland

- Boardman has been a Magistrate Judge for the U.S. District Court of Maryland since September 2019.
- Boardman served as a Federal Public Defender for the District of Maryland from 2008 to 2019. She was appointed the First Assistant Public Defender in 2015.
- As a magistrate judge, Boardman ordered the Baltimore Police Department to release documents pertaining to the conviction of <u>Malcom Bryant</u>, who was convicted of murder and later exonerated by a DNA test.
